National Library of Latvia

The National Library of Latvia or the Castle of Light. This is one of the most significant cultural buildings in the history of restored Latvia. The library's new building was opened in August 2014, designed by the world-renowned Latvian architect Gunnar Birkerts.

The library also houses the "Dainu skapis" (Cabinet of Folksongs), a world cultural treasure included in the UNESCO Memory of the World Register. The core of the library collection of more than four million items is the national heritage – materials about Latvia and Latvians, Latvian and foreign publications, as well as works by Latvian authors.
